Personal equipment advise

Troop equipment list

Get sledge down and get it into working order

Alternative plan to sledge

Get all Patrol equipment together in advance and familiarize Scouts with it

All Scouts planning to attend come properly dressed to meeting

Fire

- preparation of tinder, kindling and fuel from 2x4's using hatchet and knife
- demonstrate fire building and starting in can stove
- stock of 2x4's in equipment to take
- plan an assignment of tasks for whole Patrol to be involved in the building, starting and maintaining of the fire and the cooking of the food.
- Patrol leader must be mentally and physically ready to eat what is cooked no matter what

First aid review

- Tenderfoot
 - 12a) Heimlich
 - 12b) cuts and scratches, blisters, burns, bug bites, snake bites, nosebleed, frostbite and sunburn
- Second Class
 - 6a) "Hurry" case of stopped breathing, serious bleeding, and internal poisoning.
 - 6c) Demonstrate first aid for: object in eye; bite of suspected rabid animal; puncture wounds from splinter, nail and fishhook; second degree burn; heat exhaustion; shock; heatstroke, dehydration, hypothermia, and hyperventilation
- First Class
 - 8b) Bandages for sprained ankle, injuries head, upper arm and collarbone
Practice making bandages out of old sheet.
 - 8c) Demonstrate one and two man transport of victim from smoke-filled room, and sprained ankle for 25 yards
 - 8d) Tell 5 most common signs of heart attack. Explain CPR steps.

Tripod lashing with hook. Practice making it and using it

Compass work

- Review basic compass use with giant demo
- Have each Scout measure his step for 10', and walk 10' blindfolded Have each Scout face in 8 directions, with bag on head and walk stated distance
- go over concept of pacing off different polygons using compass headings

Signaling – Decree what code is to be used, teach it, give each Scout a study sheet

Group skis –

- fabricate group skis for practice
- practice walking in step in close formation, including turns. After mastered under PL's command, try with some APL's
